




Julimar Complex: New ground in a new nickel-copper-PGE region




- Recent high-grade palladium and associated nickel-copperplatinum group elements (Ni-Cu-PGE) discovery by Chalice Gold Mines Limited (ASX:CHN) has kicked off an exploration boom in the region.
- DevEx has secured a strategic +620km² position:
 - Exploration Licence Applications (100% DEV) overlying several magnetic targets of the Julimar Complex considered prospective for magmatic Ni-Cu-PGE.
 - 2. Recent Earn-In Agreement with Australian Silica Quartz Group Ltd (ASQ), to earn 50% in the mineral and metal rights (excluding bauxite) on the ASQ tenement give immediate exploration access.

Sovereign Project is located between the Chalice discovery and Yarawindah Brook Ni-Cu-PGE Project (Cassini Resources; ASX: CZI)


Sovereign Project: Multiple "late-time" conductors identified, up to 1km long




- Airborne electromagnetic (AEM) survey completed –
 preliminary data defining Multiple AEM conductors the
 Kingsley, Mackenzie and Hudson Prospects identified.
- The AEM conductors are seen in the "late-time" channels only, supporting the potential for underlying massive sulphides within the Complex.
- A ground moving-loop EM survey is now planned to better define and model these conductors in advance of RC/Diamond drilling.



Sovereign Nickel-Copper-PGE Project: Support for Julimar Mafic-Ultramafic Rocks





Airborne magnetic (RTP) and new AEM targets (yellow outline)

Ground gravity (Residual Bouguer) and new AEM targets (yellow outline)

- Sovereign Project is covered by extensive laterite (bauxite) development masking underlying rocks.
- New ground gravity survey and recent laterite geochemistry supports potential for underlying mafic and ultramafic intrusions of the Julimar Complex – host to the recent Ni-Cu-PGE discovery by Chalice.
- Re-assay of historical surficial bauxite drilling, together with DevEx rock chips.

Assays of up to 1,210ppm nickel (Ni), 395ppm copper (Cu), 6,830ppm chromium (Cr) and 83ppb palladium + platinum (Pd+Pt)

RC/Diamond drilling planned to target ground MLEM targets





- Significant rerating of the region following 2017 government mapping project² recognised rocks as the southern extension of the Junee-Narromine Belt.
- No previous drilling within a globally-recognised copper-gold region for decades.
- DevEx has built a large, +600km² 100%-owned ground holding:
 - Basin Creek Gold Project
 - Junee Copper-Gold Project

Basin Creek Project: +3.5km gold system defined at Main Ridge Prospect




- Large-scale, continuous system of gold-in-soil anomalies, +3.5km in length at the Main Ridge Prospect.
- Rock chips returned grades of up to 8.0g/t gold in strongly altered felsic to intermediate volcanic and porphyry rocks.
- 14 hole reconnaissance RC/Diamond program nearing completion – partial test of gold system.
 - Assay results received for 5 of the northern holes narrow zones of gold mineralisation encountered in 2 holes.
 - Assays pending for 9 holes in the central and southern areas.
 - RC and Diamond holes (9) in central and southern zones show broader zones of hydrothermal alteration (incl silica-sericite-pyrite) and quartz sulphide (pyrite, galena, chalcopyrite) stockwork veins.

Next Steps

• Phase 2 drilling to be determined once all assays received and a full geological evaluation is completed (~4 weeks).



Junee Project: Underexplored with no prior exploration drilling for +25 years

- 2017: Re-rating with Government mapping identifying porphyry monzonite intrusion (Cu-Au bearing Cooba Monzonite) contemporaneous with the Cu-Au bearing Northparkes and Cadia Ridgeway porphyry intrusions².
- +20km of prospective strike.
- 2020: DevEx's maiden exploration has identified several porphyry Cu-Au targets.
- Drilling underway to test several porphyry Cu-Au targets at Billabong Creek, Riversdale North, and Nangus Road Prospects.



Junee Project: RC / Diamond drilling

Riversdale North:

 RC/Diamond drilling of IP Anomaly underlying oxidised copper associated with epidote veins and alteration, including a gold + base metal gossan assaying 2.81g/t Au, 0.4% Cu and 1.3% Pb.


Nangus Road:

- Diamond drilling targeting buried magnetic anomaly, similar to Cu-Au bearing Cooba Monzonite.
- New Frontiers Cooperative Drilling Grant awarded by NSW Government to drill Nangus Road target.


Billabong Creek:

 First diamond drill hole targeting coincident magnetic/gravity low and 800m long IP anomaly - intersected a strongly altered silicified sediment with fine pyrite stringer veins and quartz pyrite veins – assays pending.

Junee drilling program is expected to take four weeks to complete, with assay results to follow



Cobar Gold-Base Metal Projects: DevEx expands NSW portfolio in the highly prospective Cobar Basin region



New discovery opportunities further strengthen DevEx's high-quality NSW copper-gold exploration strategy:

I. Wilga Downs Gold-Base Metal Project

 Recent Earn-In Agreement with Thomson Resources Ltd (TMZ), to earn 80% on granted Exploration Licence giving immediate exploration access.

2. North Cobar Exploration Licence Application

 Additional Exploration Licence lodged within the highly prospective North Cobar Mineral Allocation Area.



Generalised Geology Map of the central Cobar Mining District after David (2006)¹, showing location of Wilga Downs Project and tenement applications.



Wilga Downs Project: Planning underway to drill prospective target

- Strong coincident magnetic and gravity high identified beneath historical anomalous copper, lead and zinc intercepts.
- Magnetic/Gravity highs located on the prospective fault contact between Cobar Supergroup and Girilambone Group.
- Priority target is similar to other gold-polymetallic Cobar deposits:
 - Glencore's CSA Copper Mine
 - Peak and Great Cobar Copper-Gold Mines
- Many of these deposits form discrete magnetic highs at the fault contact between Girilambone Group and Cobar Supergroup.




Wilga Downs Project: Planning underway to drill prospective targets



- Magnetic/Gravity anomaly located on the prospective contact between Cobar Supergroup and Girilambone Group.
- Historical drilling above main magnetic/gravity highs has intersected anomalous Lead, Zinc and Copper.
- New Frontiers Cooperative Drilling Grant awarded by NSW Government to drill Wilga Downs target.

Preparations underway for a RC/Diamond drill program to test high-priority target in the coming months

NSW Gold, Copper-Gold Projects

- **Basin Creek Gold Project:**
 - Initial drilling is nearing completion.
 - Next round of drilling will be determined once all assays have been received, and priority targets identified.
- Junee Copper-Gold Project:
 - RC and Diamond Drilling underway.
 - Drilling due for completion in mid-November 2020.
- Wilga Downs Gold-Base Metal Project:
 - Preparations underway for a RC/Diamond drill program to test highpriority target in the coming months.

Sovereign Nickel-Copper-PGE Project

- AEM survey has identified strong "late-time" conductors up to 1km long.
- Follow-up ground-based EM geophysics to define conductors.
- Objective to generate and drill targets in coming months.
- Progress Applications to grant and advance Land Access over coming months.




